## **ITCC Welcomes** **Indian MSME Business Delegation**

On 28th January, the ITCC welcomed a business delegation from India comprising MSMEs from a wide range of sectors, including factory relocation and warehouse automation, industrial engineering, manufacturing of engineering components, supply chain and logistics, industrial packaging, cloud infrastructure and system architecture design, CAD/CAE services, and financial services.

The delegation expressed a strong interest in exploring Thailand as a strategic gateway to Southeast Asia. One of the companies has already secured orders from Thailand and is considering establishing a physical presence in the country, with interest in becoming a member of the ITCC.

The meeting focused on India–Thailand trade and investment opportunities, collaboration prospects for MSMEs under the India–Thailand Strategic Partnership signed in April 2025, key considerations for setting up a business in Thailand, and an overview of ITCC membership benefits.
